- The full room cost of any agent you need to take that supports your archer will be helped to be funded.
- Any archers that have a reason to have a single room, the AU will meet the full cost of the room.
- Proposal to put out a form to get the ideas of how many people will be taken to BUCS Outdoors and drivers.
 - Will propose to AU about a mini-bus in the worst case scenario.
 - Any person who wants an agent to BUCS Outdoors will need a reason for this.
- o A question about whether you require a single room will be included.
- o Both agents and room requirements both need to be **reasoned**.
